<p>Linguistic Activity: Play password with 5 of the vocabulary words. Think of three related words that would lead someone to guess the vocabulary word.</p>	<p>Logic Activity: Choose 10 different vocabulary words and scramble their letters to make a list of scrambled vocabulary words.</p>	<p>Musical Activity: Use the new vocabulary to create a short jingle set to a familiar song.</p>
<p>Body-Moving Activity: Spell each word out using your body.</p>		<p>Social Activity: Pick one word & make a 30 second charade in French acting out the meaning.</p>
<p>Reflective Activity: Pick one word and make a flyer that illustrates the words and defines it.</p>	<p>Naturalist Activity: In English, describe 5 vocabulary words using your five senses. **</p>	<p>Spatial Activity: Make a paper cube. Paste an image on each of the 6 squares. Roll the cube and say the word that lands up in the target language.</p>

** example: croquet-monsieur – looks square, sounds crunchy, feels warm, tastes cheesy, smells tasty
