

THE AATF ANNOUNCES DESIGN CONTEST

The AATF is pleased to announce the continuation of a contest to design a badge/emblem/logo which reflects Francophonie, globalization, and promotes the speaking and learning of French as a 21st-century skill. The finished digital artwork should be 4x4 inches in size and submitted in a common graphics format (.jpg, .pdf, .eps) at a resolution of at least 300 x 300 dpi. No copyrighted figures (ie. Snoopy, Astérix) will be accepted.

Only one submission per student will be accepted, and the student's teacher must be an active AATF member. The deadline for submissions is **December 1, 2017**. E-mail each entry as an attachment to [designcontest@frenchteachers.org] with the student's full name in the subject line. The message should include the teacher's name, school name, and full contact information (including e-mail) for both the student and teacher.
